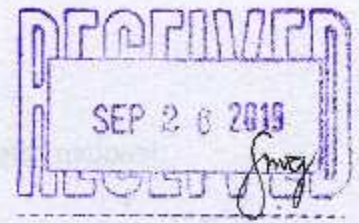

### **EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2019 - 55**

#### **AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE PRE-MARRIAGE COUNSELING TEAM (PMC) OF MOGPOG**

**WHEREAS**, the Pre-Marriage Program is a flagship endeavour of the government designed to help engaged couples understand their roles, rights and obligations as married partners and would-be parents;

**WHEREAS**, presidential Decree No. 963 requires engaged couples to attend a Pre-Marriage Counselling session before they are issued a marriage license;

**WHEREAS**, DILG-DSWD Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01, s. 2010, provides that city/municipal mayors shall organize the Pre-Marriage Counselling Team and shall effect the implementation of the PMC Program particularly the issuance of circular/directives for an effective and responsive PMC Program implementation including the provision of annual budget for the PMC team and the effective conduct of PMC sessions;

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, **AUGUSTO LEO M. LIVELO**, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby promulgate this Executive Order creating the Pre-Marriage Counseling Team of the Municipality of Mogpog;

#### **Section 1. COMPOSITION**

**Section 2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS:**

1. Develop and maintain a responsive mechanism to effectively implement the PMC program in the municipality;
2. Advocate for the effective implementation of the PMC Program to ensure continued awareness and support for the program;
3. Undertake preparatory activities for the PMC sessions by
  - a. Disseminating information about the PMC program through the radio, community assemblies, barangay meetings, and other media outlets;
  - b. Posting schedules of PMC sessions in the offices of the Local Civil Registrar Office, offices of the mandatory members of the PMC team, and other noticeable places in the municipal hall;
  - c. Ensuring appropriateness, readiness and availability of a venue for PMC sessions;
  - d. Preparing schedules of PMC sessions for mandatory team members to enable them to plan these activities;
  - e. Ensuring the availability of PMC supplies and materials.
4. Conduct a PMC session to not more than 15 couples at a time;
5. Issued PMC certificates which are signed by accredited mandatory PMC team members to engaged couples who have completed the PMC session.

**Section 3. EFFECTIVITY**

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
